Terms & Conditions 2012

TUITION

1. Cancellations before the course has started

If you cancel your course more than 4 weeks before it starts, you will be refunded your fees less the deposit of £200. If you cancel your course less than 4 weeks before it starts fees will not be refunded.

2. Cancellations after the course has started

If you cancel your course after it has started you must give at least 4 weeks' notice. Fees will **not** be refunded but you will be given a credit note for any remaining tuition fees. This credit note is valid for 12 months. The credit note is not transferable.

3. Visa refusal

If you are refused your visa and do not wish to reapply we will refund your full fees, minus £100 of the deposit and any fees incurred (i.e. bank charges, DHL, etc.). You must send your original visa refusal letter from the embassy before any refund will be issued. If you decide to re-apply, the deposit and any further fees paid will be carried forward.

4. Changes/postponement prior to arrival

If you make any changes to or postpone your course prior to the start date, which requires the reissuing of papers, we reserve the right to charge a £30 administration fee.

5. Changes after arrival

After your course has started you cannot reduce your hours of tuition. No compensation is given for reduction in hours or hours missed once the course has started.

6. UK National Holidays

There is no compensation for days missed due to UK national holidays.

7. Student Holidays

Holidays during your course can only be booked at the time of registration. Any holidays requested after that cannot be compensated and tuition will be lost for weeks missed.

ACCOMMODATION

1. Changes/postponement/cancellation in homestay accommodation prior to arrival

If you change, postpone or cancel your homestay accommodation less than 1 week before arrival, we reserve the right to apply a £30 charge to compensate the family.

2. Changing your homestay accommodation after arrival

If you want to change your homestay accommodation after you have arrived, you must give at least 1 week's notice. We reserve the right to charge a £30 administration fee.

3. Cancelling your homestay accommodation after arrival

If you cancel your homestay accommodation after you have arrived, you must give at least 4 weeks' notice. The balance of the accommodation fees after this period will be refunded less a £30 administration charge.

4. Cancelling your residential accommodation before arrival

If you cancel your residential accommodation more than 4 weeks before you are due to arrive, you will be refunded your tuition and accommodation fees less the deposit of £250 for the course and residence.

5. Postponement of residential accommodation before arrival

If you postpone your residential accommodation less than 4 weeks before you are due to arrive, a £50 compensation charge applies for every postponement.

6. Changing from residential to homestay accommodation

You must give at least 2 weeks' notice if you want to change from residential to homestay accommodation after you arrive. A compensation charge of £50 applies (If you decide to leave the residence with a notice period of less than 2 weeks the full fees apply for the notice period).

7. Cancellation of residential accommodation after arrival

If you cancel your residential accommodation after you arrive, you must give at least 4 weeks' notice. The balance of the accommodation fees after this period will be refunded less the £50 deposit and £30 administration charge.

8. Student holidays

There is a family retainer fee of £50 per week for the duration of your holidays. For residential accommodation, full fees apply during your holidays.

VARIOUS

1. Payment

The school reserves the right to withdraw a student from class if fees have not been paid.

2. Alterations

The school reserves the right to alter the content, timetable and fees of the course without prior notice.

3. Liability

Any damage to school property, whether intentional or not, may have to be paid for. The school cannot accept liability for the loss of money or personal possessions. Please ensure you have adequate insurance cover.

4. Misconduct

The school reserves the right to exclude from class any student who is restricting the progress of the class because of bad behaviour or poor attendance. If the school is required to withdraw a student because of misconduct no fees will be refunded.

5. Supervised social activities

Registering for a course implies permission for the student to participate in all supervised activities outside the school premises which form part of the school programme.

6. Medical emergency

In cases of medical emergency the school will act as loco parentis.

7. Use of images

Select English may use photographs or video images of students for future promotional purposes. Students (and parents of students in the case of children) should inform the school prior to the course start date if they do not wish to permit use of such images.
